In recognition of eighteen years of professional commitment, leadership, and service to the Decision Sciences Institute, Southwest Region, Timothy Paul Cronan has been selected to receive the Distinguished Service Award. He has been a member of both the Southwest Decision Sciences Institute (SWDSI) and the Decision Sciences Institute (DSI) since 1978.

Dr. Cronan has served the SWDSI as President (1988-89), President Elect (1987-88), Vice President for Programs (1986-87), Vice President for Membership (1985-86), Vice President for Student Liaison (1981-82, 1983-84), member of the Advisory Council (1993-96), and representative on the Southwestern Federation of Administrative Disciplines (SWFAD) Board of Directors (1987-89). He also has served the DSI as Regional Vice President (1989-91) and member of the Board of Directors (1989-91), Development Committee for Excellence in the Decision Sciences (1995-97), Innovative Education Committee (1986-88), Nominating Committee (1992-94), Publications Committee (1989-91), and Regional Activities Committee (1987-89).

Dr. Cronan's professional activities at both SWDSI and DSI conferences have included numerous paper presentations and participation in several symposia and workshops. He was selected as recipient of the SWDSI Distinguished Paper Award in 1984. In addition, he has been Track Chairman on four occasions (1981, 1982, 1984, and 1990) and *Proceedings* editor (1987) for SWDSI; and has participated as manuscript reviewer, session chair, and discussant for various conferences.

For his outstanding contributions to the organization, the Decision Sciences Institute, Southwest Region, proudly confers upon Timothy Paul Cronan its Distinguished Service Award.
