In recognition of professional commitment, leadership, and service to the Decision Sciences Institute, Southwest Region, David E. Douglas has been selected to receive the Distinguished Service Award. He has been a member of both the Southwest Decision Sciences Institute (SWDSI) and the Decision Sciences Institute (DSI) since 1986.

Dr. Douglas has served SWDSI as President (1996-97), President-Elect (1995-96), Vice President for Programs (1994-95), member of the Committee on Nominations (1997-99), representative on the Southwestern Federation of Administrative Disciplines (SWFAD) Board of Directors (1994-97), and has served as the secretary/treasurer of SWFAD (1998-2001). As a member of DSI, Dr. Douglas has served as Associate Program Chair (1998-99) and as a member of various national committees including Regional Activities Committee (1995-95), Committee for Information Technology (1995), and Publications Committee (1990).

Dr. Douglas' professional activities both at SWDSI and DSI conferences have included frequent paper presentations and participation as manuscript reviewer, discussant, and session chair. In addition, he has served as track chair and as Proceedings editor (1995) for SWDSI.
