Peggy L. Lane, Ph.D.



In recognition of thirty-two years of professional commitment, leadership, and service to the Decision Sciences Institute, Southwest Region, **Dr. Peggy L. Lane** is the recipient of the 2022 Lifetime Achievement Award. She will retire in August 2022 after 28 years of teaching and 4 years in industry. Dr. Lane serves as the JoAnn and Miles Sager, Jr. Endowed Professor of Computer Information Systems at the University of Louisiana Monroe. She has served in various administrative roles at Missouri Western State University, Emporia State University, and the University of Louisiana Monroe including Associate Dean and Interim Dean. She has received the SWDSI Outstanding Educator Award, SWDSI Distinguished Service Award, and numerous college teaching recognition awards. Peggy was the third person to earn a PhD from the University of Arkansas with a major in Information Systems (1992). She taught with SAP for 10 years including the TERP10 certification course. Her research includes ERP, entrepreneurship, impacts of culture on technology acceptance, information systems teaching pedagogy, and assessment.

Dr. Lane has been a member of the Southwest Decision Sciences Institute (SWDSI) since 1990. She has actively served SWDSI as well as the Federation of Business Disciplines (FBD) in various leadership roles such as Coordinator of Registration and FBD President and has exhibited valuable professional service to the organizations. Dr. Lane has served SWDSI in numerous ways including Chair of the Strategic Planning Committee (2016-2017), President of SWDSI (2015-2016), SWDSI Program Chair (2013-2014), and SWDSI Council Member for approximately 8 years. She currently serves SWDSI as the Regional Archivist. She has served as a committee member on a variety of SWDSI committees throughout the past 29 years, notably the Outstanding Educator Award Committee and the Distinguished Service Award Committee. Her professional activities at SWDSI and DSI have included the presentation of numerous papers and participation in a variety of workshops, and panel sessions, such as the Graduate Student Workshop, as well as annual meeting involvement as a Track Chair, reviewer, and session chairperson.
