Dr. Pavur has been an active member of the Southwest Decision Sciences Institute since 1982. He has served SWDSI as President (1997-1998), President-Elect (1996-1997), Vice President for Programs (1995-1996), Chair of Administrative Disciplines (SWFAD) Board of Directors (1996-1998), and Vice President of Student Liaison (1987-1988). At the 1995 DSI Conference, he was a mentor for the New Faculty Consortium program.

Dr. Pavur has presented thirty-seven papers at the national and regional meetings of the DSI, an outstanding demonstration of his excellence as a researcher. In 1987 he received the SWDSI Distinguished Paper Award, and he was *Proceedings* co-editor for SWDSI in 1996. In addition, he has been track chairman four times at national and Southwest DSI regional meetings, and he will serve as track chair of the Statistics track for the 2000 national DSI Conference. He has served as a manuscript reviewer, session chair, and discussant for numerous conferences.
