In recognition of professional commitment, leadership, and service to the Decision Sciences Institute, Southwest Region, G.W. Willis has been selected to receive the Distinguished Service Award. He has been a member of the Southwest Decision Sciences Institute (SWDSI) since 1984 and the Decision Sciences Institute (DSI) since 1987.

Dr. Willis has served SWDSI as President (1994-95), President-Elect (1993-94), Vice President for Programs (1992-93), Vice President of Member Services (1990-92), and representative on the Southwestern Federation of Administrative Disciplines (SWFAD) Board of Directors (1992-95). As a member of DSI, Dr. Willis has served on the Service Committee (1990-1992), Programs and Meetings Committee (1994-1996), and Nominating Committee (1996-1998).

Dr. Willis's professional activities both at SWDSI and DSI conferences have included frequent paper presentations and participation as manuscript reviewer, discussant, and session chair. He has served as track chair (1988, 1989) and as Proceedings editor (1993) for SWDSI. Dr. Willis has also assisted with the DSI Academic Administrators Workshop as a panelist (1998, 2000) and coordinator (1999).

For his contributions to the organization and the profession, the Decision Sciences Institute, Southwest Region, proudly confers upon G.W. Willis its Distinguished Service Award.
